

- **ADVANCE RESERVATIONS ARE REQUIRED FOR CAMPING!** Limited camping for rafters is available for \$15/person per night the night before and/or after your rafting trip. Call 530-626-5600 to reserve.
- **Tents, sleep kits and sleeping pads are also available to rent.** (A sleep kit includes a sleeping bag, sheet liner, camp pillow and sleeping pad.) Please call for prices.
- **ALL CAMPSITES ARE WALK-IN ONLY.** Hand carts are available to help move your gear to your campsite. Please return them as soon as you're done.
- **Our campground is not equipped to charge electric vehicles,** but we may be able to accommodate you in an emergency with explicit permission from our on-site management team and we will charge a service fee. Please ask an OARS staff member before plugging in your vehicle and **DO NOT** unplug anything in order to charge your vehicle.
- **Trucks, vans or vehicles with rooftop tents, RVs and trailers less than 30' long are welcome to be parked in our parking lot, with advance notice.** Hook-ups are not available. *Generators are strictly prohibited.* Ask us about local campgrounds that can accommodate your needs.
- **NO DOGS are allowed at our campground.** Please make arrangements for your pets and accept our apologies with this policy.
- **Check-in is between 3:30 – 8 PM.** Please check in at the OARS American River Outpost store between 3:30 – 6 PM. If your schedule requires you to arrive after 6 PM or if you're running behind, prior arrangements can be made by calling our office during regular business hours (7 AM – 6 PM).
- **Quiet hours are between 10 PM and 8 AM.** Please be mindful of your neighbors who also want to enjoy their vacation! Turn off electronics and keep noise levels to a minimum.
- **Amplified music is not permitted in order to allow natural sounds to prevail.**
- **Flashlights and/or headlamps are a necessity.** Lighting is minimal and it can get very dark.
- **This is a smoke-free campground.** Please limit smoking to the designated smoking area at the far end of the parking lot.
- **The smaller your tent, the more options you'll have on where to put it.** While in camp, please consolidate your belongings so there's plenty of room for everyone. Small (8' x 10') backpacker-type dome tents are recommended (No jumbo tents).
- **Campfires must only be built in the existing fire pans.** Due to state fire restrictions, campfires and charcoal grills are not permitted after Memorial Day. For your cooking needs, please bring your own gas stove or grill.
- **Guest dish washing sink** is provided near Upper Camp for your convenience.
- **Please leave our tables, chairs, benches, etc. where they are.**
- **Showers and changing rooms.** 6 individual showers/changing stalls are available for use during your stay. Please bring your own towel and toiletries.
- **Be gentle on our septic system.** Don't try to flush feminine products, trash, or large amounts of toilet paper down the toilet. Please use the provided bins to dispose of trash.
- **Leave your valuables at home or lock them in your car during the day.** OARS cannot be responsible for any damage to your car or anything taken from it. Car keys can be stored while you're on the river.
- **OARS prepared meals may be available for an additional charge.** Please call 530-626-5600 for details.

## **RAFTING GUESTS:**

**If you're rafting on the day you are departing please clear your campsite prior to your trip.**

If you're not rafting on your departure day, please pack and empty your campsite by 11 AM.

You may stay and enjoy our facilities, however we need to ready the site for our next guests.
